Darla and Irene share fruit leftovers from the BC School Fruits and Vegetables program with the Family Centers.  Deb applied for a Healthy Eating Action Schools Food grant. She applied for \$300 each for 4 of the 5 schools in the west boundary area. She hopes to use the funds for sporting events when the need arises. She also suggested that out of each of the \$300 allotments \$50 be donated to BCSS for their programs. The high school didn't fit the criteria of the grants.  Hoops for Hearts – Cathy requested PAC pay for Fruit and Juice for GES for Hoops for Heart.  Calendar – Deb had a concern with the Terry Fox Run and the School Picture Day. They might be in conflict with the 4H event in Kamloops. Darryl didn't think we had a choice when the school pictures took place.  There was some concern raised about P/T interviews happening before the report cards come out. P/T interviews are set with the bussing schedule. We could possibly bump it back a little bit.  Hot Lunch – Leslie thought we should still have a hot lunch at the end of February. Perhaps with the 4 hot lunches in Greenwood in January and GES going skiing 3 x perhaps just a hot lunch at MES.
