Challenge is a formal process whereby a student may receive course credit without taking the course by demonstrating achievement of learning outcomes prescribed by a provincial or local curriculum.

The Board of School Trustees believes that students' prior learning that corresponds to a provincial or locally developed course at the graduation level should be acknowledged and credited.

In accordance with Ministry Policy Circular (issued 96-06-18), secondary schools will allow students, in exceptional circumstances, to challenge designated Grade 11 and 12 courses.

The Challenge Policy recognizes the realities of working and learning in a knowledge-based society.

R E G U L A T I O N S

The Provincial Policy on Challenge outlined in Ministry Policy Circular #96-04 and the Ministry Handbook of Procedures will prevail.
