The Board of School Trustees, through the provisions of the Guidelines for Awarding School Board School Completion Certificates, supports the awarding of a School Board School Completion Certificate. This Certificate is intended to support secondary school students with special needs or other students who have succeeded in meeting goals of their educational program other than graduation.

Administrative Guidelines for Awarding School Board School Completion Certificates is as follows:

- The student must achieve the goals and objectives of the individual educational plan established for the student.
- The Principal will consult with the student's teachers in order to determine whether the student has met the criteria for being awarded the certificate.

The Principal, in consultation with the Superintendent or designate, may create the School Completion Certificate in a way that reflects the Boundary School District as well as conveys the information set out in the provincial template.
