The School Planning Councils (SPC) are organized and operate as follows:

1. Name

The School Planning Council (SPC) for each school shall be named as follows:
School Planning Council – (Name of School)

2. Purpose

The School Planning Council (SPC) provides parents, teachers and the Principal with an advisory process as they:

2.1. Review the draft School Growth Plan prepared by the Principal

2.2. Prepare the annual School Plan

2.3. Advise the Principal regarding the:

- School Growth Planning binder
- Data included or the need for data
- The School Plan (Ministry Form)
 - the process used to identify goals
 - the information reported
 - the targets and levels established

The School Planning Council must meet requirements outlined in the School Act: “By a date specified by the Board, a School Planning Council must prepare and submit to the Board a plan for the school in respect of improving student achievement and other matters contained in the Board’s Accountability Contract relation to the school.” [8.32(2)]

“The School Planning Council must consult with the Parents’ Advisory Council during the preparation of the School Plan.” [8.3(3)]

The School Planning Council provides advice to the School Board with respect to:

- allocation of staff and resources in the school
- matters contained in the Board’s Accountability Contract relating to the school
- educational services and educational programs in the school

The School Planning Council does not engage in discussion or provide advice regarding:

- personal/confidential information on students, teachers, parents, or other employees
- complaints about individual
- personnel matters
