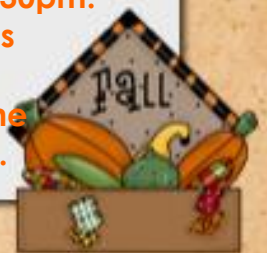
Homeroom Wars
