FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN LOSS OF BUS PRIVILEGES

PARENTS/GUARDIANS:

My signature below indicates that I have read, understood, agree and have discussed with my child, the terms and conditions outlined for riding the school bus.

1. It is the parents' responsibility to determine how their children will safely travel to and from school or to and from the bus pick up and drop off locations.
2. The bus driver is the authority at all times.
3. Students must remain seated and facing forward while bus is in motion. Arms and legs must be kept out of the aisle and inside the windows.
4. Loose items, such as backpacks, to be placed at your feet.
5. No unsafe articles such as skateboards, unguarded skates or hockey sticks allowed on the bus.

REMEMBER:

This bus must transport students safely, so any action that may cause an unsafe condition will not be tolerated. Student behavior is a significant factor in bus safety. Codes of Student Conduct apply when riding school buses. Also, students who ride buses will be asked to sign a bus riding contract each year.
