POLICY 123 ROLE OF THE BOARD VICE-CHAIR

The Board Vice-Chair supports the Chair as necessary.

The Board Vice-Chair is an equal, with no more power or authority than any other trustee. Although the Vice-Chair assumes a leadership role, they must adhere to the Board's directions and may not act unilaterally.

The Board assigns to the Vice-Chair the following responsibilities:

- 1. To act on behalf of the Board Chair, in the their absence and assume all the duties and responsibilities of the Board Chair.
- 2. To assist the Board Chair in ensuring that the Board operates in accordance with its own policies and procedures and in providing leadership and guidance to the Board.
- 3. Prior to each Board meeting, confer with the Board Chair, Superintendent and Secretary-Treasurer on items included on the agenda, and become thoroughly familiar with them.
- 4. Performother duties and responsibilities assigned by the Board Chair.
