~~As required under Section 76.1(b) of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, the~~ In accordance with the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, the Board of Education designates the Superintendent of Schools ~~(hereafter referred to as "the Freedom of Information Head")~~ as the official head of the School District for the purposes of the Act.

~~The Board and~~ authorizes the Secretary-Treasurer ~~(hereafter referred to as "the Freedom of Information Coordinator")~~ to ~~to~~ issue any procedures required to support the district's administration of the Act ~~be responsible for the administration of the Act~~ and to make any required operational decisions. ~~The Freedom of Information Coordinator is authorized to issue any procedures to support the administration of the Act.~~
